## Wax-Resist Watercolors

This is a classic art project using crayons and watercolor paints.

Supplies:

- Watercolor paper or sturdy paper
- Watercolor paints
- Water
- Paintbrush
- Crayons

## Instructions

- 1. Always write your name on your art!
- 2. Draw your design on your paper-White crayon can look really cool after you paint but can be really hard to see when coloring, I usually use a



light color like yellow or light blue so I can see what I am coloring!

- 3. Paint over your design with watercolors, be sure to use enough water so that your paints can flow off of the wax left behind by your crayon.
- 4. Wait for you art to dry then hang it in a place of honor (like the fridge)
