

TENTH ANNUAL MAZIN ART EXHIBITION

The Mazin Annual Art Exhibition was conceived and created by Bernice and Benjamin Mazin and the Jewish Community Center's Visual Arts Committee. The event is funded by the Mazin Visual Arts Fund and is a regional juried art exhibition of 2-D and 3-D art, open to artists 18 years and older. The exhibit is designed to foster an appreciation of today's visual art and to reflect the breadth of artistic vision of local artists.

ELIGIBILITY

- Entries must be original works of art completed after January 1, 2013.
- Artists must be 18 years of age or older and reside within 200 miles of Louisville, KY.
- Artwork must not exceed three feet in any dimension and sculpture must not exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- Reproductions, artwork produced for a class and jewelry are not eligible.

APPLICATION

- Each artist may submit up to three (3) works. A digital file of each should be included.
- Artwork should not be photographed through glass nor should the artist's name appear on the work.
- Label each digital file with the following information: artist's name and title of work
- Complete the attached entry form. Artist's name, title of piece, medium, year completed and dimensions/weight must be included on the entry form. Additional forms may be picked up at the JCC, calling 502-459-0660 or online at www.jccoflouisville.org. Entry forms must be postmarked on or before **October 21, 2015**.
- A \$25 fee for one piece and \$5 for each additional piece for up to a total of three pieces or \$35 must accompany the entry form and digital file(s). Make check payable to Jewish Community Center (JCC). Payments are non-refundable.
- Digital files will not be returned.

CONDITIONS

- Accepted artwork must be available for the entire duration of the exhibition.
- Work other than that represented on the digital files and chosen by the juror may not be substituted.
- Artists may not submit artwork that has been previously exhibited or entered for jurying in other JCC Patio Gallery shows.
- Digital files of accepted work become property of the JCC, which retains the right to reproduce and distribute images to print and electronic media.
- The JCC reserves the right to photograph accepted works for publicity, documentation and educational purposes.
- All accepted works must be strongly framed and suitably wired for hanging. No clip frames or sawtooth hangers are permitted.
- Work will be insured while on exhibit by the JCC at 70% of the sales price.
- The JCC will retain 35% commission on sales. Artwork does not have to be for sale, but a sale price must be included for insurance purposes.

DELIVERY

- The artist is responsible for delivery to and pick up from exhibition.
- All work must be delivered to the JCC Patio Gallery by hand on November 18, 2015 between 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
- No shipped or mailed pieces will be accepted.
- Artwork must be picked up on December 30, 2015 between 9 a.m.-5 p.m.

OPENING RECEPTION AT THE PATIO GALLERY

All exhibiting artists and their guests are invited to a reception at the opening of the exhibition from 2 p.m.-4 p.m. on Sunday, November 22, 2015. The reception will be held in the JCC Patio Gallery and prizes will be awarded at 3 p.m.

JUROR

Our juror this year is **Luanne Rimel**, a textile artist, curator, instructor, and currently the Director of Education Programs at Craft Alliance Center of Art + Design in St. Louis, Missouri. Her photographic imagery and textile work has been exhibited both nationally and internationally, including Japan, China and Korea, traveled with Quilt National 2011 and 2013 and has been exhibited in the Smithsonian Craft Shows for the past 3 years. Luanne's work was recently featured in the book *Art Quilts of the Midwest*, by Linzee Kull McCray, University of Iowa Press and is in many private and corporate collections.

Other exhibitions include a solo exhibit at the Missouri Botanical Gardens, St. Louis, MO; Art Quilt Elements, Wayne, PA; and the Chicago Cultural Center, Chicago IL.

Luanne received an MFA in Fibers from Southern Illinois University and has taught numerous workshops and classes around the country. Rimel's work will be seen at the Patio Gallery in 2017.
